How it all Works and the Costs!

Rescues.... about rehabilitation and rehoming:

- An assessment of health and socialisation levels reveals the dog's readiness for rehoming.... only after those tests, can we consider adoption!
- The CDH Walking Group provides so much value during this phase.... walking on-/off-lead, exercise, socialisation and basic commands.
- Dogs may need a specific, rehabilitative dietary programme.... CDH is proud of the "before and after" successes.
- The dog is groomed.... bathed, nails clipped, ears and feet cleaned. Then, photographs are attempted.... not always the easiest of tasks with lots of bouncing around, hiding and licking the photographer!
- If the new family is local, we arrange a home visit. If the new home is in the UK, we use the services of a CDH ambassador. Of course, when the new home is abroad, there are more Vet visits and admin.... a responsible, transporter is booked and dogs are carefully crated....they go with our love!
- NO adoption fee... only a donation request. Many pay nothing!
- Once settled, we try to stay in contact with the new family.

THE SAFETY AND HAPPINESS OF OUR DOGS IS ALL THAT MATTERS TO US! WE'RE ALWAYS HAPPY TO SEE THEM GO, BUT THEY LEAVE WITH PIECES OF OUR HEARTS!

Rescues.... about what happens behind the scenes:

- There's a cry for help! from the public, a Vet, a shelter and/or a friend/supporter.
- Dogs are hard to catch.... they disappear or sustain an injury.... it can take days!
- The rescued pooch is immediately examined by a Vet.... checked for a micro-chip, leishmaniasis, heartworm and tick fever.... a visual check is done and samples sent for Lab evaluation. Vaccinations and micro-chipping are done!
- Quarantine is mandatory (10-14 days) - monitoring reveals latent conditions, eg, Parvo.... then, it's final vaxes. If age appropriate, sterilisation is arranged.
- Until fully vaxed at 12 weeks, puppies are mostly quarantined and are only available for adoption after that. They stay in Sharron's home, only handled by staff, to avoid Parvo. An outbreak of Parvo carries terrible sadness and enormous costs.... we lost two puppies and 16 were desperately ill during an outbreak in 2022.
- Fractures/wounds may need surgery and/or long-term treatment. As with behavioural issues, this delays rehoming. When too severe, the dog becomes an **"Honoured Resident"** and sponsorship is sought. Thank you to our supporters and friends!!
- A heartbreaking amount of newborns are found in plastic bags, dumped in trash cans with the garbage! Often, extraordinary measures are necessary to ensure their survival... 2-hour bottle feeding for the first four weeks.... exhausting work!

Our Haven.... upgrades and maintenance

- Running costs are high... maintenance and upgrades are complex and hard work!
- We have a contingent of amazing volunteers but still need hired staff for continuity.
- Ongoing renovation and maintenance of kennels.... our dogs must be comfortable!

Other costs not reflected in summaries....

- Surgery, treating injuries and long-term conditions and/or emergencies.
- Heartworm - €400-500
- Tick Fever - €120
- Parvo outbreak - 2022 - €8,000
- Special diet chicken/rice - €200/month.
- Sterilisation of external dogs/cat - €850
