Hendrix was hit by a car last year and another association helped with his surgeries. The owner has decided that he no longer wants to keep this very sweet boy.

His Vet check revealed many small wounds and patches of hair loss. He tested negative for Leish and heartworm thankfully, but was positive for tick fever. The Vet said that the hair loss could be down to an allergy, or stress. Only time will tell. He's around 5-years old and has been chipped and vaccinated for rabies.... the other vaccinations will have to wait because he needs medication more urgently, for the tick fever. Because he was quite bloated, deworming has also been done.

He is quite timid, but soft and loving..... if he could talk, we feel strongly that he'd be thanking Mena, the volunteer who brought him to us.





UPDATE - November 23

Hendrix has been thriving the past few weeks he's completed his treatment for tick fever and will be receiving the balance of his vaccines once he's had his next Vet check.

We're thrilled that his skin issues have cleared up with baths and Omega 6&3 oil supplements ...but feeling safe, secure, loved and eating healthy foods have likely led to his speedy recovery.

Hendrix is not a dog that needs extensive walking due to his previous (fixed and healed) broken leg....but he does love walking. He loves the beach and people. He is non-reactive with other dogs and seems to be VERY good with cats - he loves going out in the car.
